Administrative information for all competitions

General Rules: Competitions are held under the rules of the MSF and World Aquatics.
All competitions on this calendar are opened to swimmers licensed by a federation affiliated with World Aquatics [except for Masters].

Officials: The jury is constituted by the referee in accordance with World Aquatics rules.
The appointment of the referee is the responsibility of the FMN.

Team of Officials: Each club must provide officials in proportion to the number of swimmers entered [see table below].

Withdrawals/scratch for finals should be made 30 minutes after results of heats are out. No Show will be subject to a fine <u>Finals:</u> Only 1 final will be overall per gender with a maximum of 3 non-Mauritian citizens. <u>Foreigners:</u> Only 2 invited foreigners and 2 resident foreigners can access finals.

Information About Mauritian Competitions

Foreigners' Swimmers:

FOR FD & GP:

Individual events:

- Foreigners may participate in FD and GP events if they are licensed with a Mauritian club or a foreign club affiliated with the WA.
- For podium place, only the best foreigner will be eligible for a medal in each event.

Relay events:

- A local club may register only one foreign athlete in the team.
- A foreign club may register only one team in an event.
- Only one foreign team may receive a medal on the podium.

FOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Individual events:

- May swim in heats, but only two best swimmers will qualify for the TC finals.
- Only the best of the two will be eligible for a championship medal if he/she is among the 3 best in any event.
- 3 Top Mauritian swimmers in each event are eligible for championship medals [Gold, Silver, Bronze].

Relay events:

- A local club may register only one foreign athlete in the team.
- Each foreign team may enter a relay team, but only the best of these teams will be eligible for a championship medal.

👉 This system makes it possible to offer international-level competition (thanks to the participation of foreigners) while protecting national titles and recognition of national achievements.
